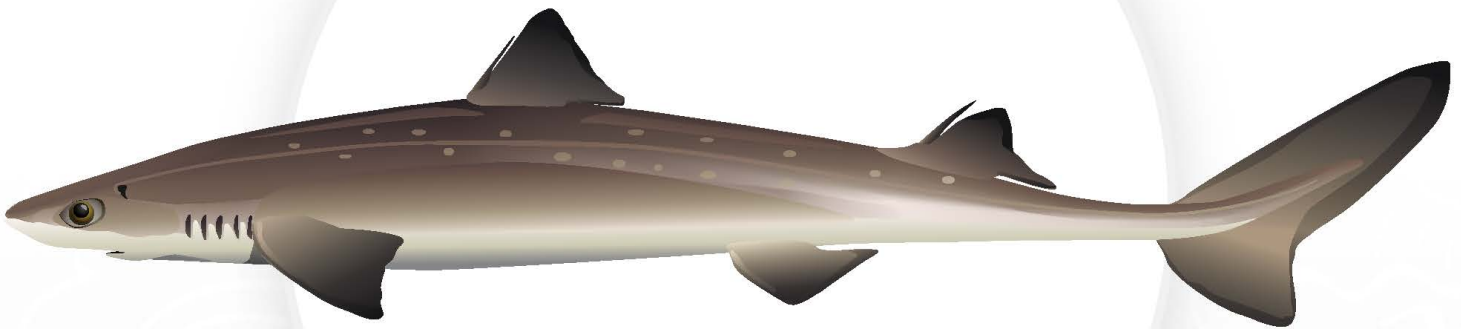


# What's the deal with dogfish?

A small species of shark, dogfish has traditionally been a lower-valued species, and it is overly abundant in the Gulf of Maine—even threatening to compromise the balance of the ecosystem . With more demand for dogfish, there is the potential for \$12 million in economic benefit to fishermen and an additional \$26 million in increased economic activity throughout the supply chain.
